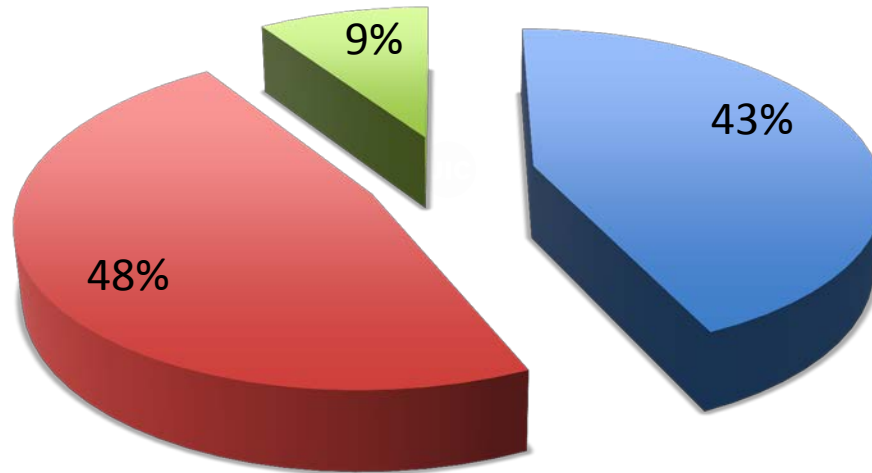

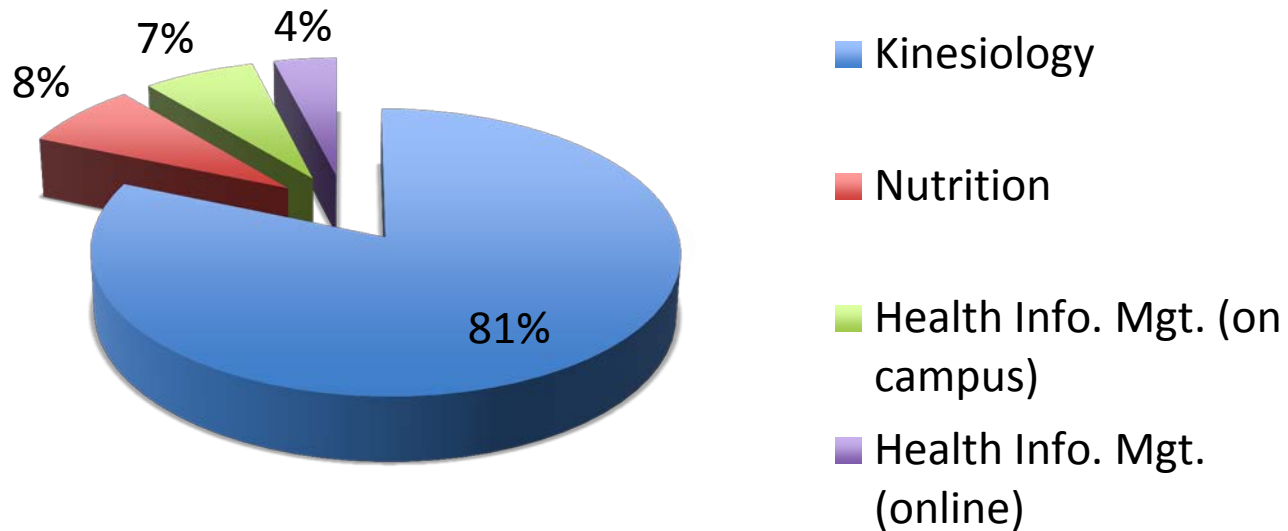

KINESIOLOGY (BS)

Two Concentrations:

- **Movement Science**
 - **Explore how physical activity, disease and pathologies, and aging process affect movement**
 - **Understanding of how anatomy & physiology of human musculoskeletal and neural systems interact to create the range of human motion**
- **Exercise Science & Health Promotion**
 - **Workplace wellness and health promotion.**
 - **Experiential learning emphasized**



KINESIOLOGY (BS)

Intercollege Transfers:

- Only accept applications for fall
- Apply by end of 7th week of Spring term
- General Biology w/ lab (or Chem 101) and PreCalculus must be complete prior to applying



Rehabilitation Sciences(BS)

New Program beginning Fall 2015:

- **Social Science degree that integrates educational expertise of each of our academic departments**
- **Focus on: disability, human function, and rehabilitation from multiple perspectives including – health sciences, psychology, engineering, social sciences and other related fields**
- **For Fall 2015, intercollege transfers at freshmen/sophomore level being accepted**
