## Minimum Requirements for Admission

Admission to the College of Education from another UIC college is generally available to students in good academic standing who have a UIC term and cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.50 (A=4.00). Students must complete at least one semester of coursework at UIC.

Applications are reviewed after the semester ends and grades posted. Students will be notified of their application decision via their UIC email address prior to the start of the following semester. Applications for Spring 2017 admission are due by May 1. Apply online at beginning March 1.
